Health & Safety

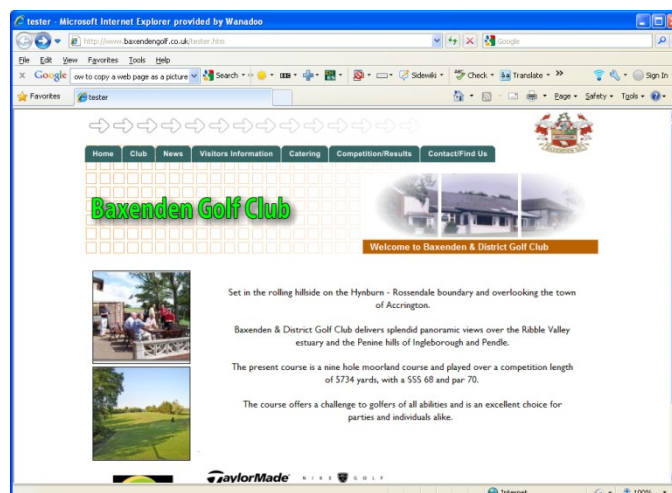
Portable ramps to provide improved disabled access are in production and will be in position soon.
